Journalism & Media Studies Transfer Pathway 2022-2023

This pathway assumes completion of an AA-T in Journalism OR least 60 transferable credits including the equivalents of HCOM 170 Intro to Mass Communication and HCOM 280 Intro to Reporting, and all CSU Lower Division General Education and American Institutions requirements.

Transfer Students with an AA-T in Communication Studies need to take HCOM 180 and HCOM 280 if not completed prior to transfer but only need one Intermediate Storytelling course.
