Program 1. Cultural Competency: World Readiness Standards

5 Saturdays, 9AM to 4PM: September 19, November 7 & December 5, 2015;

February 20 & April 23, 2016

How can we as language teachers prepare our students for the future? Look to MBWLP to provide the specific insights and knowledge for you to help your students become culturally competent and ready for the world. Learn to build lessons aligned with Common Core and California State Standards that can develop their communication proficiency, critical thinking and other important skills needed for success in the 21st century.

Program 2. Winter Session: Standards-Aligned Instruction Using Technology

2 Saturdays, 9AM to 4PM—January 23 & 30, 2016

Create and explore basic applications and web-based resources (web 2.0) that you can readily use in your classroom with your students. Build engaging lessons aligned with the World Language and Common Core Standards. Today’s students will enjoy your class more when you’ve added technology to their learning tasks as they become more proficient in the target language.

Program 3. Summer Session: Standards-Aligned Thematic Unit Design Using Technology

3 consecutive days, 9AM to 4PM—Mon., Tues. Wed. June 13, 14 & 15, 2016 (tentative)

These three days will give you time to get practice necessary to design lessons that use technology to create lessons that will stimulate your students to dive into and take more responsibility for their progress. You will be able to benefit as well from the experience of other teacher participants and come away with meaningful lessons aligned with the Common Core and CA World Language Content Standards.
