To honor Coll's life and unwavering dedication to marine mammals, the National Marine Mammal Foundation established the Coll Gordon Perske Memorial Fund for Marine Mammals. The mission of the fund is to improve the lives of marine mammals, with a focus on California sea lions, through scientific research, education, and promotion of ocean stewardship.
