

Undergraduate Alumni Experience Study Report – 2017

California State University, Monterey Bay - Institutional Assessment and Research

Executive Summary

Between September 21, 2017 and November 30, 2017, 5,377 CSUMB undergraduate alumni were invited to participate in a survey to assess their experience with CSUMB. Alumni were asked to reflect on the degree program that they participated in and the ways in which their participation influenced their professional growth, employment, and future plans. An incentive drawing for a gift from Amazon.com worth up to \$400.00 was offered to respondents. In total, 1,337 undergraduate alumni responded to the survey for an overall response rate of 25%.

Key Takeaways

Overall Satisfaction with CSUMB & Major

- 88% of respondents were satisfied (55%) or very satisfied (33%) with their overall education experience in their major at CSUMB.
- 70% would probably (23%) or definitely (47%) choose the same major if they were to start CSUMB over again.
- 82% would probably (31%) or definitely (51%) recommend their CSUMB major to prospective students.
- 73% would probably (31%) or definitely (42%) choose to attend CSUMB if they could start college over again.
- 82% said that CSUMB probably (38%) or definitely (44%) met their expectations.
- 65% said that beyond any financial benefits, their CSUMB education improved the quality of their life considerably (37%) or a great deal (28%).

Satisfaction with CSUMB Major

- 88% were satisfied (46%) or very satisfied (42%) with the quality of teaching.
- 70% were satisfied (48%) or very satisfied (22%) with the variety of course offerings.
- 81% were satisfied (51%) or very satisfied (30%) with the course content (curriculum).
- 82% were satisfied (49%) or very satisfied (33%) with the overall program quality.
- 74% were satisfied (38%) or very satisfied (36%) with the capstone.
- 66% were satisfied (35%) or very satisfied (31%) with service learning.
- 78% were satisfied (31%) or very satisfied (47%) with faculty mentors.
- 53% were satisfied (28%) or very satisfied (25%) with the opportunity to engage in research outside of class assignments.
- 72% were satisfied (43%) or very satisfied (29%) with team work / collaboration.

- 57% were satisfied (31%) or very satisfied (26%) with laboratory facilities. 15% of respondents responded “Not applicable/No basis to judge”.
- 38% rated the academic rigor (challenging academic standards and expectations) in their major as very (32%) or extremely (6%) rigorous.
- 55% would probably (23%) or definitely (32%) consider pursuing a Master’s Program in their major if CSUMB were to offer it.

Satisfaction with CSUMB Academic Goals

- 61% agree (41%) or strongly agree (20%) that their CSUMB education contributed substantially to their ability to apply quantitative skills to problems (i.e., math, statistics).
- 87% agree (44%) or strongly agree (43%) that their CSUMB education contributed substantially to their ability to evaluate information critically.
- 82% agree (39%) or strongly agree (43%) that their CSUMB education contributed substantially to their ability to give oral presentations.
- 86% agree (40%) or strongly agree (46%) that their CSUMB education contributed substantially to their ability to learn effectively on my own.
- 86% agree (39%) or strongly agree (47%) that their CSUMB education contributed substantially to their ability to search for and find reliable information.
- 75% agree (42%) or strongly agree (33%) that their CSUMB education contributed substantially to their ability to solve complex real-world problems.
- 83% agree (31%) or strongly agree (52%) that their CSUMB education contributed substantially to their ability to understand people of different cultural, racial, and ethnic backgrounds.
- 86% agree (42%) or strongly agree (44%) that their CSUMB education contributed substantially to their ability to work effectively with others.
- 80% agree (42%) or strongly agree (38%) that their CSUMB education contributed substantially to their ability to write effectively.

Influences on Academic Success

- 73% said courses they took influenced their academic success to a large (43%) or very great (30%) extent.
- 71% said interaction with faculty influenced their academic success to a large (31%) or very great (40%) extent.
- 63% said interaction with peers influenced their academic success to a large (35%) or very great (28%) extent.
- 39% said interaction with staff (e.g., residence life, student support services, or staff from other campus programs) influenced their academic success to a large (20%) or very great (19%) extent.
- 45% said participation in service learning influenced their academic success to a large (23%) or very great (22%) extent.
- 62% said completion of a capstone influenced their academic success to a large (31%) or very great (31%) extent.
- 60% said faculty mentoring influenced their academic success to a large (26%) or very great (34%) extent.
- 35% said peer mentoring influenced their academic success to a large (22%) or very great (13%) extent. 14% responded that they had “No basis to judge”.
- 25% said participation in undergraduate research (research with a faculty) influenced their academic success to a large (13%) or very great (12%) extent. 46% responded that they had “No basis to judge”.
- 14% said participation in study abroad influenced their academic success to a large (4%) or very great (10%) extent. 78% responded that they had “No basis to judge”.
- 15% said participation in first-year seminar influenced their academic success to a large (9%) or very great (6%) extent. 37% responded that they had “No basis to judge”.

- 20% said participation in a living-learning community influenced their academic success to a large (12%) or very great (8%) extent. 52% responded that they had “No basis to judge”.

Internship Experience at CSUMB

- 35% of respondents participated in an internship while at CSUMB.
- 70% of those who did an internship said that it led to further employment or helped with other employment opportunities.

Graduate School Experience

- 76% have completed or plan to complete another degree, credential, or certificate program since graduating from CSUMB.
- 34% applied to graduate/professional school.
- 34% had completed an additional degree, credential, or certificate program since graduating from CSUMB.
- 62% agree (40%) or strongly agree (22%) that their undergraduate education prepared them well for graduate educational pursuits.
- 76% said their graduate area of study is moderately (22%) or very (54%) related to their CSUMB undergraduate major.
- 66% said their graduate area of study is moderately (20%) or very (46%) related to their CSUMB concentration.
- 24% said their graduate area of study is moderately (8%) or very (16%) related to their CSUMB minor. 58% responded “Not applicable/No basis to judge”.
- Of those that chose not to attend graduate or professional school, not being able to afford to attend graduate school (21%) and pressure to work instead of furthering education (18%) were the most frequent reasons provided.

Professional Skills

- Of those respondents that went on to graduate or professional school:
 - 74% had attended an academic / professional conference.
 - 25% had presented their research at a professional conference.
 - 13% had published an article in a journal or other professional publication.
 - 21% had helped write a grant proposal.
 - 31% had served on departmental / institutional committees.
 - 31% had reviewed papers, served on disciplinary society committees, or engaged in other forms of service to their profession.
 - 30% had served as an officer or leader in a professional organization or society.
 - 53% had engaged in local educational outreach activities or programs related to their field of study.
 - 33% had communicated research to a broader audience (e.g., outreach, science education, action research . . .)
 - 60% had used their education or research to impact a real-world problem or issue.
 - 76% had mentored other students.

Employment and Career

- 70% of respondents had obtained full-time paid employment following graduation. 18% had obtained part-time paid employment.
- 63% said their current employment is moderately (24%) or very (39%) related to their CSUMB major.
- 50% said their current employment is moderately (17%) or very (33%) related to their CSUMB concentration. 12% responded “Not applicable”.
- 82% said their undergraduate education probably (44%) or definitely (38%) prepared them well for employment opportunities.

- 70% of respondents said they often (28%) or very often (42%) are able to take a leadership role at work.
- 37% said they often (19%) or very often (18%) are able to take leadership roles in their community.
- 48% said they often (23%) or very often (25%) are able to contribute to the welfare of their community.
- 62% said they often (28%) or very often (34%) are able to use their education and work to address real-world problems.
- 47% said they often (21%) or very often (26%) are able to serve in professional organizations in their field.
